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Note: PA-C and HSC Assistants will continue to be paid at 90% of all fee schedule rates for professional services.

RVU Calculation = current year's max fee schedule amount divided by the current year's conversion factor of \$63.25. RVU is "total" RVU. To calculate "work" RVU for local codes, multiply "total" RVU by 0.5.

 - Case management/team conference (99367),
 - Phone call/online communication (99441-99444), or
 - E/M consultation (99241-99245)
- Psychologist Advisor:
 - Case management/team conference (99366, 99368), or
 - Phone call/online communication (98966-98969)

*** Be sure to include the additional 10% in the total charged amount when billing with the -8R modifier code.**

 - 99444 (physician),
 - 98969 (ARNP, PA, psychologist)
- Work-site visit and job modifications (requires claim manager authorization):
 - 0389R (job modification/pre-job mod),
 - 0390R (work evaluation)
- Expenses incurred in providing 0389R or 0390R services (requires claim manager authorization):
 - 0391R (travel/wait),
 - 0392R (mileage),
 - 0393R (ferry charges)

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
